JesusVsBible 11c - The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone. Whoever falls on that stone will be broken; but on whomever it falls, it will grind him to powder. (Lk 20:17-18)

JesusVsBible 10c - You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me. But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life. (Jn 5:39-40)

Obedience 7b - You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble! (Jas 2:19)

Obedience 6c - Bear fruits worthy of repentance, and do not begin to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' (Lk 3:8) I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision, but declared... that they should repent, turn to God, and do works worthy of repentance. (Acts 26:19-20)

Obedience 5a - As the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also. (Jas 2:26)

James 2

Obedience 10d - Live as free, yet not using liberty as a cloak for vice, but as bondservants of God. (1 Pet 2:15-16) You have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. (Gal 5:13)

1 Peter 2; Galatians 5

Obedience 9b - Not the hearers of the law are just in the sight of God, but the doers of the law will be justified. (Rom 2:13) But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. (Jas 1:22)

Obedience 8b - For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God? (1 Pet 4:17) But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our report?" (Rom 10:16)

(Lk 14:33) Sell all that you have and distribute to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me. (Lk 18:22)

LivingByFaith 5c - Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession and he kept back part of the proceeds, his wife also being aware of it, and brought a certain part and laid it at the apostles' feet. But Peter said, "...You have not lied to men but to God." (Acts 5:1-10)

LivingByFaith 4b - The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field. Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking beautiful pearls, who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had and bought it. (Mt 13:44-46)

LivingByFaith 3c - There is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands for My sake and the gospel's, who shall not receive a hundredfold now in this time... with persecutions, and in the age to come, eternal life. (Mk 10:29-30)

LivingByFaith 13b - For you remember, brethren, our labor and toil; for laboring night and day, that we might not be a burden to any of you, we preached to you the gospel of God. (1 Thes 2:9)

LivingByFaith 12b - For in (the Gospel of Christ) the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith." (Rom 1:16-17) No one is justified by the law in the sight of God, for the just shall live by faith. (Gal 3:11) The just shall live by faith but if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him. (Heb 10:38)

RichVsPoor 3c - Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, passion, uncleanness, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. (Col 3:5) For this you know, that no fornicator, unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any part in the kingdom of Christ and God. (Eph 5:5)

RichVsPoor 2a - Blessed are you poor, for yours is the kingdom of God... But woe to you rich, for you've received your consolation. (Lk 6:20,24) Has God not chosen the poor of this world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him? (Jas 2:5-7) Come now, you rich, weep and howl for your miseries that are coming upon you! (Jas 5:1-5)

Outreach 7d - Do you not say, 'There are still four months and then comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! (Jn 4:35)

Community 10d - He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ till we all come to the unity of the faith ...to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ. Community 13d - Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are... I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in unity, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me. (Jn 17:11,23)

Outreach 3c - When I say to the wicked, 'You shall surely die,' and you give him no warning, nor speak to warn him from his wicked way, to save his life, that man shall die in his sin; but his blood I will require at your hand. Opposition 4b - Remember the word that I said to you, 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also. (Jn 15:20) Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution. (2 Tim 3:12)

Opposition 7a - For we have found this man a plague, a creator of dissension among all the Jews throughout the world, and a ringleader of the sect of the Nazarenes. (Acts 24:5) We desire to hear from you what you think; for concerning this sect, we know that it is spoken against everywhere. (Acts 28:22)

Opposition 10c - When you go with your adversary to the magistrate, make every effort along the way to settle with him, lest he drag you to the judge, the judge deliver you to the officer, and the officer throw you into prison. I tell you, you shall not depart from there till you have paid the very last mite." (Lk 12:58-59)

FalseTeachers 3b - For there are many insubordinate, both idle talkers and deceivers, especially those of the circumcision, whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole households, teaching things which they ought not, for the sake of dishonest gain. (Titus 1:10-11)

Opposition 3a - And it was told Him by some, who said, "Your mother and Your brothers are standing outside, desiring to see You." But He answered and said to them, "My mother and My brothers are these who hear the word of God and do it. (Lk 8:20-21)

Opposition 6a - It is enough for a disciple that he be like his teacher, and a servant like his master. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebub, how much more will they call those of his household! (Mt 10:25) Blessed are you when men hate you, exclude you, revile you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of Man's sake. (Lk 6:22)

Opposition 9c - Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it. (Lk 9:23-24)

FalseTeachers 2b - Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. You will know them by their fruits. (Mt 7:15-20)

FalseTeachers 8b - Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men; for you neither go in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in. (Mt 23:13-28; Lk 11:42-52)

Outreach 8a - Reject a divisive man after the first and second admonition, knowing that such a person is warped and sinning, being self-condemned. (Titus 3:10-11)

Opposition 2a - If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple. (Lk 14:26) He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. (Mt 10:37)

Opposition 5b - You will be hated by all for My name's sake. But he who endures to the end will be saved. (Mt 10:22) If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you. If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you. (Jn 15:18-19)

Opposition 8b - Do not give what is holy to the dogs; nor cast your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you in pieces. (Mt 7:6)
